INDOOR/OUTDOOR DINING PAUSED:

Suburban Cook County is experiencing an increase in Coronavirus positivity rates and in hospitalizations due to Coronavirus. Indoor dining in Wilmette and surrounding suburbs was recently suspended by an order from Governor Pritzker, and Mather Place is following suit. For now, we have **paused all restaurant service** in our community. We'll monitor local data and guidelines to determine when restaurants at Mather Place may re-open.

While we have paused all indoor and outdoor dining in our community, we encourage you to take advantage of our meal delivery and carryout options and enjoy them in your apartment home. Doing so is the best way to avoid the risks that come from eating with others, and in turn helps protect the entire community.

Options include meal delivery to your apartment or carryout. If you would like carryout, select the "to go" box on your menu, along with when you want to pick up your meal. To-Go Bags will be ready for pick up in Patent's restaurant:

- Breakfast To-Go Bags are available at 8:30 a.m.
- Schedule dinner pick-up for at your choice of 5:00 or 6:00 p.m.

As always, we'll offer a selection of entrees, sides, and more for each meal.

With the rise in local cases, we ask that you continue to take steps to protect yourself and others. **Please be consistent in practicing physical distancing, proper hand hygiene, and wearing a mask that covers your nose and mouth.**
