Dear Residents and Family Members,

We received notice yesterday, November 14, 2020, that **two employees of Mather Place have confirmed positive cases of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19)**. These employees are recovering at home and following guidance from their physicians. We wish them a speedy recovery. Mather is interviewing these individuals to determine if either of them was in close contact with residents and/or other employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

BE VIGILANT— PRACTICE THE THREE WS:

WEAR A MASK: Keep your nose and mouth covered.

WASH YOUR HANDS: Use soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use an alcohol-based sanitizer.

WATCH YOUR DISTANCE: Keep at least 6 feet of space between yourself and others.
