Dear Residents and Family Members,

We received notice yesterday, February 1, 2021, that **a private caregiver of Mather Place in Wilmette has a confirmed positive case of COVID-19.** We wish them a full recovery. The home care agency has interviewed this individual to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

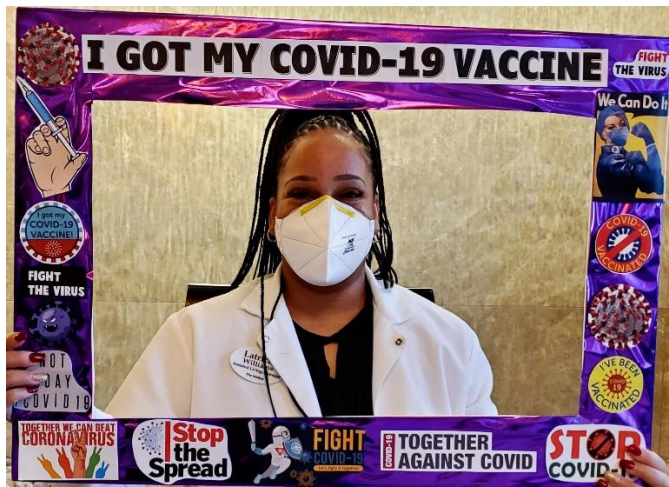
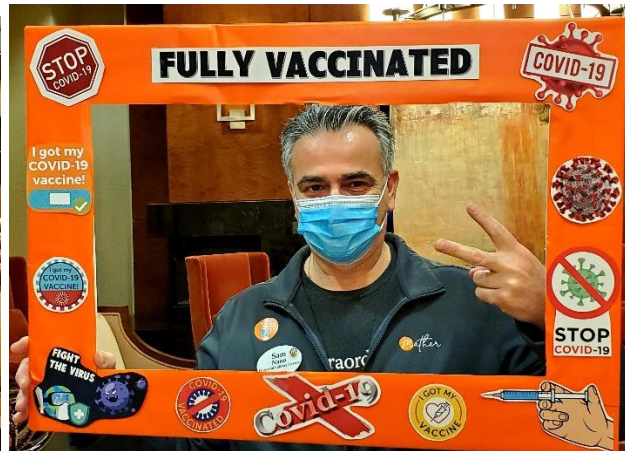
If you have questions about the vaccine, we encourage you to do some research—including speaking with your primary care physician. It is important to get information from reliable sources such as the CDC.
