

COVID-19 UPDATE

May 9, 2022

Dear Residents and Family Members,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **one resident and three employees have tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish these individuals a speedy recovery.

Mather Place is interviewing the individuals to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

WEAR A MASK IN AMENITY SPACES:

Please continue to be diligent about wearing a well-fitting mask while in the public areas and amenity spaces inside our community. Please also wear a mask if you are home when Mather Place team members are inside your apartment home.

FEEL ILL? PLEASE STAY HOME:

COVID-19 can present similar symptoms to a cold, flu, or even allergies. Even if you are experiencing mild symptoms, please err on the side of caution with these steps:

- **Stay in your home to avoid spreading a virus.**
- **Take a COVID-19 test.** Please contact your personal physician if you have questions about at-home tests versus PCR testing.

REDUCE YOUR RISK:

As we continue to live with COVID-19, we know how to reduce risk of infection:

1. Get your second booster shot.
2. Wear a well-fitting mask every time you are indoors in public space.
3. Practice good hand hygiene by washing hands frequently for 20 or more seconds.
4. If you think you have COVID-19 or were exposed to COVID-19, get tested.
