Dear Residents and Family Members,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **a resident has tested positive for COVID-19**. We wish this individual a speedy recovery.

Mather Place is interviewing the individual to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS:

Please protect yourself and others with some simple steps:

1. **if you are experiencing any symptoms—even mild, cold-like symptoms—we strongly encourage you to stay home and avoid spreading any illness you may have to others.** If you think you have COVID-19 or were exposed to COVID-19, get tested.
2. **Wear a well-fitting mask** that covers your mouth and nose when indoors in a public area.
3. Practice **good hand hygiene** by washing your hands frequently for 20+ seconds.
